

Who We Are

Incarnational Ministry

New Life practices incarnational ministry in the heart of English Avenue, an under-resourced neighborhood on Atlanta's Westside.

Incarnational ministry involves being intentional about building relationships with neighbors, and being more deeply engaged in their lives as they face challenges and victories.

God is revealing a broader vision for our community and how we play a part in it. Some of the opportunities that lie before us include:

- Building a vibrant spiritual life among our diverse congregation by discipling our brothers and sisters in Christ;
- Developing our community garden as a space for special worship, outreach events and recreation; and
- Catalyzing and convening neighborhood conversations regarding issues that need attention and action, like vacant housing and street violence

This is a powerful vision, and we trust God will bring it to pass.



Mattie Freeland Community Garden

Only blocks from the church is the Mattie Freeland Community Garden, named for a 50-year resident of the community and matriarch of the church. This garden, started by New Life in 2008, was formerly a lot where abandoned cars, garbage and other debris had accumulated for many years.

New Life members cleaned the lot and built raised garden beds. Through various partnerships, the garden has expanded to include eleven raised beds, a picnic area, a small playground and field for neighborhood kids to play on, and a shed for housing garden tools.

The garden exists to provide a space for neighbors to get to know one another and for children to learn about nutrition and environmentally sustainable practices.

In the coming years, we will cultivate greater community involvement through adopt-a-plot initiatives, cooking demonstrations, barbecues/festivals, movie screenings, and other outreach events.

The garden serves as a testament to God's transforming power at work around us.
